Purpose of study	<p>to reveal the process of formation of a single world political space during the epoch of colonialism,</p> <p>to reveal mechanisms of formation and functioning of colonial empires, the struggle of Eastern peoples for sovereignty and equal status in interstate relations,</p> <p>to show the place and role of Eastern countries and peoples in the modern system of international relations, increase of their importance in world economic and political processes under the global redistribution of power and the appearance of new world and regional centers of power.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- to show the peculiarity and specificity of the colonial policy of the leading states of the world towards the peoples of the East;</li> <li>- to consider the international legal basis of the system of unequal treaties between the countries of the West and the East;</li> <li>- to define the role of the economic component and its treaty registration in relations of the capitalist powers with the countries of the East in the conditions of the world market formation</li> <li>- to consider the formation of regional subsystems of international relations;</li> <li>- to show the role of the "Soviet factor" in international relations in the East;</li> <li>- to show the inevitability and concrete forms of the collapse of colonial empires and the acquisition of sovereignty by the countries of the East;</li> <li>- to examine the place and role of the countries of the East in international relations under the bipolar structure of the world order;</li> <li>- to show the growth of influence of Eastern countries on global processes after the dissolution of the bipolar world order; to trace the formation of new "centers of power" in the modern system of international relations;</li> <li>- to determine the impact of the religious, civilizational and cultural components on the nature of contemporary international relations.</li> </ul>
